## Dvar Torah Parshas Vayeitzei Rabbi Yaacov Marmor

Have you ever wondered why Hashem has scattered the Jewish people to the four corners of the earth throughout our long galus? Why didn't he just send us to one location to suffer our full term of exile? Why the need for the constant expulsions and relocations?

Furthermore, there are some locations in galus where the Jewish people have left and never come back, while there are others where they lived, left, and later returned. For example, Germany has seen a resurgence in their Jewish population since the holocaust which now stands at 118,000, while the great communities of Babylon (Iraq) never saw a significant Jewish return. What determines the difference?

The answer to these questions lies in this week's parsha. Yaakov Avinu is perhaps the first Jew sent into galus, and he ends up in the house of Lavan the Aramean. It is in Lavan's home that Yaakov builds his family, but it is also there that he suffers at the hands of his deceptive father-in-law.

After 20 years of living in Lavan's home, Yaakov is finally given the prophetic message that it's time to move on, and he flees without even informing his host. Eventually Lavan catches up with Yaakov, and after a heated argument, they make a truce.

The Maggid of Mezrich explains that "Hashem was the one who caused Lavan to chase after Yaakov. Yaakov had left behind letters from the Torah which he had not yet extracted from Lavan. This is why Lavan pursued him, to give him the letters which remained in Lavan's home. An entire chapter was added to the Torah by these Letters."

The Lubavicher Rebbe explains that these letters were sparks of holiness that Yaakov Avinu was sent to extract from Lavan's home. Since Yaakov had left some sparks behind, Hashem caused Lavan to chase after Yaakov to return these sparks.

The Arizal writes that the reason the Jewish people are sent into galus is to extract holy sparks from the forces of impurity. Every destination in exile is really a mission to redeem the holiness that is trapped in the physical world. Once our mission in a given land is complete, Hashem sends us on to our next assignment.

This is the reason why the Jewish people have traveled the entire world during their long galus. It is also what determines how long we remain in each country we visit and whether or not we need to return there in the future.

Every day we spend outside of our homeland is part of our divine mission to gather holy sparks by performing mitzvos, learning Torah, and doing chessed. Only when our mission is complete will we return to Eretz Yisrael to enjoy the fruits of our labor.

May we do a thorough job extracting the Kedusha from North Miami Beach so that we can return to the Holy Land while we can still get great prices for our real estate.



Dear Community Member,

Great news! Our Eruv for the last 40 years has been considered Halachicly one of the finest Eruvim in the country. We are now able to make something great even better. New infrastructure will make the Eruv less subject to challenges of a hurricane, windy weather, construction and maintenance. For the first time since the original construction 40 years ago we are going to assess every family an additional \$100 in addition to the usual \$54 annual dues.

Now the depressingly sad news. Though I will bill 1,000 families that live within the Eruv boundaries, (based on previous years statistics) only fifty percent will pay. In the past, I have been harsh in saying that using the Eruv without paying is stealing; whether that is true or not is for discussion with your Rav. However, one thing is fact: If everyone who uses the Eruv would pay, then the annual payment would be less for everyone. In simple English, if someone is using the Eruv without paying, your neighbor is being forced to pay for you. It may not be stealing, but it is wrong. Beginning this year our Eruv website will be easier to use than ever. It will include links for payment as well as a way to check if you have made your payment. Initially it will be updated monthly with an alphabetical list of names with paid status. No amount paid will be shown. You can now pay your annual dues plus assessment totaling \$154 in so many convenient ways.

We are endeavoring to convert to a digital billing system. If you have an email address, please send it with your name. We will still be sending printed bills for those who prefer so. If you are paying through a business account, please include your family name and address.

Please leave me a message or a text with your question. We thank the Board of Directors of Young Israel for their continued understanding of the importance of the Eruv and having maintained bank accounts, bookkeeping etc. without any charge to the community. All payments and donations made are under the umbrella of Young Israel and are tax deductible.
