Dvar Torah Parshas Nitzavim by Rabbi Yaacov Marmor

In the week's parsha Moshe Rabainu tells Klal Yisrael that the Torah is something accessible to every Jew. "For this commandment that I command you today - it is not hidden from you and it is not distant. It is not in the heavens that you should say, "Who can ascend to heaven for us and take it for us, so that we can listen to it and perform it?"

On this pasuk Rashi comments: "It is not in heaven, but if it were you would be expected to try and scale the heavens to study the Torah." The Maharsha explains that even if the knowledge of Torah was so elevated that it was beyond our intellectual grasp, we would still be required to attempt to master it.

If the point of studying a subject is understanding it, then why would someone be required to study something that is beyond his reach?

At a Siyum for completing a tractate of Gemara we say "We toil and they (non-Jews) toil. We toil and receive payment, and they toil and do not receive payment." This statement does not seem accurate. We see with our own eyes that when non-Jews toil they also get paid. What do we mean when we say they "don't get paid"?

The answer is, that when a non-Jew toils he only gets paid if he succeeds, but when a Jew toils in Avodas Hashem, he gets paid *whether he succeeds or not. It is clear that God does not need our Mitzvos. He is perfect in every way and lacks nothing. Rather, God desires our effort. He desires our toil. He desires our heart.*

When striving for anything in life we must remember that the outcome of our effort is completely out of our control. Results are always in the hands of Hashem. The only variable that we control is how hard we try.

Rav Yisroel Salanter once said, "A Jew must never ask if something is possible, he must only ask if it is necessary." If it is necessary, then it is a worthwhile endeavor, whether it is possible or not. Success is in the hands of Hashem, but the effort is up to us.

What Rashi is telling us, is that since the purpose of creation was for the Jewish people to receive the Torah, even if it remained in the heavens, a Jew would be required to attempt to attain it. Whether that mission is possible is irrelevant. It is our job to expend every effort in making the attempt.

The most amazing aspect of this concept is that if a person approaches Avodas Hashem with this mindset, he will find that even the impossible is sometimes achieved. Hashem can do anything. If we do our part, He will do His.

May we strive to accomplish whatever the Torah demands of us, regardless of whether we deem it possible or not, and may Hashem grant us success in all of our endeavors.


