Dvar Torah Parshas Beshalach Rabbi Yaacov Marmor

There is a fascinating midrash, quoted by Rashi, that teaches us a powerful lesson regarding Emunah. The midrash states that when Moshe saw the Jewish babies being baked into bricks by the Egyptians, Moshe complained to Hashem as to how He could allow this to happen. Hashem answered that He was only "pruning the thorns", removing the wicked souls from the Jewish people before they could grow up to negatively influence the nation.

Hashem told Moshe that he could save one of the children, if he wished, so he could see the truth in Hashem's words. Moshe inadvisably rescued a child from the bricks, and the name of that child was Micha. It took some time, but approximately 60 years later Moshe discovered the consequences of his actions.

As the Jewish People were borrowing gold and silver from their Egyptian neighbors and preparing to leave Egypt, Moshe was on a holy mission, fulfilling a promise that was made 200 years earlier.

Before Yosef died, he made his brothers swear that they would take his bones with them when they eventually left Egypt. The midrash tells us that Yosef was buried at the bottom of the Nile in a metal coffin because the Egyptians thought that this would bring blessing to their water source and agriculture.

When Moshe went to retrieve Yosef's coffin from the Nile, he wrote a divine name and the words "עלי שור ער" Arise Ox! Arise Ox! on a plate and cast it into the river. Miraculously, the coffin floated to the top and Moshe was able to take Yosef's remains out of Egypt.

While Moshe was involved in removing the coffin from the Nile, Micha stealthily approached the river and retrieved the plate. Later, when Aharon was melting the golden jewelry that was contributed by the Jewish People to make the Golden Calf, Micha threw this plate into the fire and miraculously the calf, a young ox, emerged from the crucible.

Alas, Hashem's prediction came true, and the innocent child Moshe saved from the Egyptian bricks finally bore his bitter fruit. The result of the Golden Calf was catastrophic and resulted in the four Jewish exiles that were decreed as a punishment for this terrible sin.

In retrospect, Moshe's misplaced mercy in saving one child resulted in the deaths of millions upon millions of Jews throughout the generations. If only Moshe had trusted Hashem and allowed Him to "prune the thorns," perhaps this disaster could have been averted.

We rarely understand why terrible things happen in this world, but we must earnestly believe that Hashem has a master plan. This midrash is teaching us that we must trust Hashem's righteous judgment and never question His motives. In the merit of our Emunah, may Hashem reveal to us the meaning behind our suffering with the coming of Mashiach speedily in our days.
